ParentMail - Online Payments

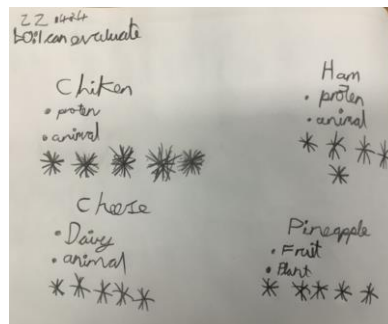
