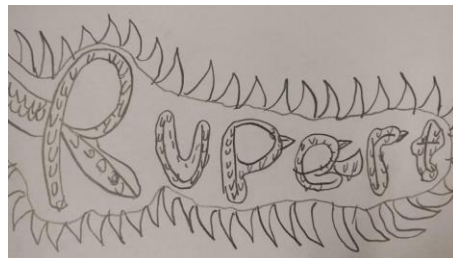
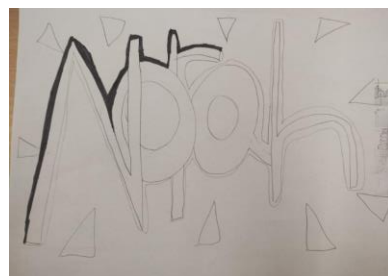
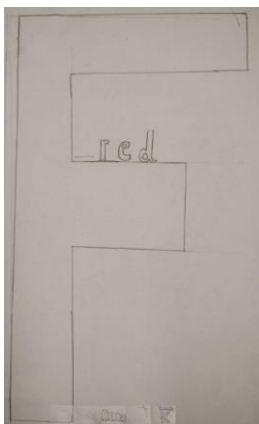
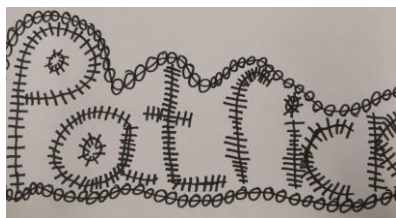


Our Curriculum
