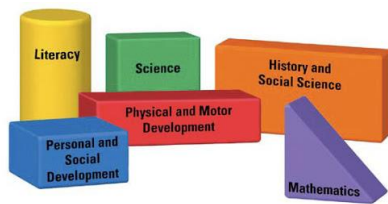
Outside of School Achievements:

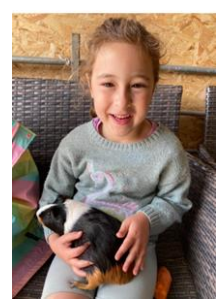
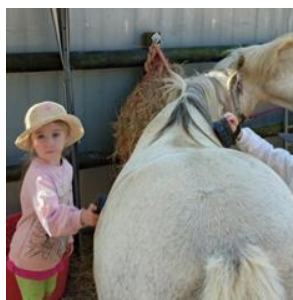


Our Curriculum
