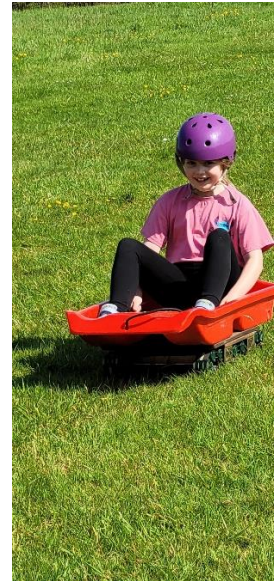


Residential Fun

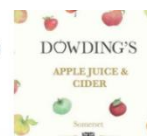
