Congratulations go to Simeon from Emerald Class and Lillian and Norah from Ruby Class for achieving their Gold Templecombe Token certificate this week.


Out of School Achievements

Curriculum Update

Emerald Class have been learning about plants in Science. They completed a 2-week experiment observing the growth of cress in light and sheltered / light and hot / dark environments. They all decorated their cress pots, planted the cress seeds on damp cotton wool and then made a prediction, choosing the location to grow their cress. A week later we then observed the effect and drew simple conclusions of the needs of plants.
