Ruby

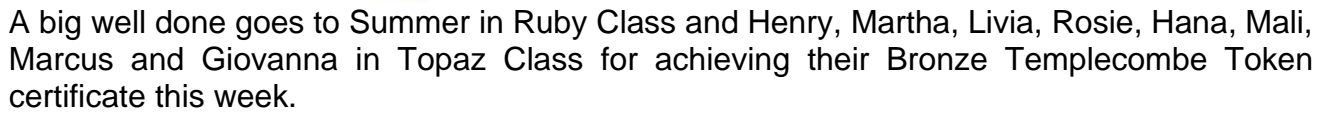
Declan for his amazing work in Maths this week.

Annabelle for working hard in Maths and always trying her best in everything that she does.

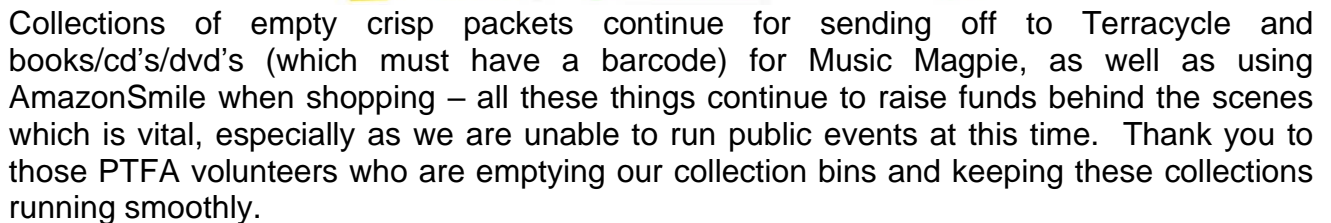
Topaz

Toby for a much improved attitude to learning since returning after Easter. Excellent participation in class and being really active at lunchtime.

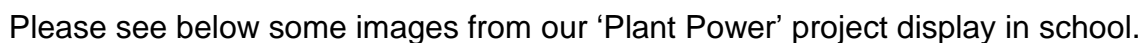
Giovanna for taking her time and really thinking about the shapes and colours of her flower when creating her 'up close' flower painting.
