Eco-Grant

A massive well done to our Eco-Council for being the first school in Somerset to receive a new £500 grant towards an Eco-inspired project. Our project details are:

We believe that our children should be well-informed about the impact we are all having on our planet; that by making small changes we can collectively make a big difference. We wish to engender a passion to protect the planet, and help them to live happier, healthier, kinder lives.

The aims of our project are:

- To reduce the environmental impact of fashion.
- To help parents to save money.
- To educate children that small changes have a big impact.

We plan to hold termly clothes exchanges based at the end of the school day. We will have donation days for targeted items and collection days where parents are welcome to take items of clothing ready for the months ahead. Any clothes that aren't collected will be stored in a repurposed storage area specially created for this purpose. It is hoped that we will build a stock of clothes across the year which can be distributed to families in need outside of the 'pop up shop' events. We will also work with food banks in our wider area to hold a stock of food locally for families and members of the community in need.
