Attendance

Hot Meals / Breakfast and After Fun Clubs

A quick reminder that all of these items are available on the Parentmail app for ease of booking and payment. Regarding Hot Meals, the deadline for ordering will be ten days, for example, this Friday is the deadline for ordering meals for week commencing 16th September. If you wish to have a paper copy of the menu for information, please call into the office to collect one.

Medication in School

Please ensure you complete a new administration of medication form (available from the office) if your child requires any form of medication to be administered in school. This includes asthma inhalers. You will soon be receiving a data collection sheet for each child for checking and updating - please check your child's medical information is up to date, to include any allergies and necessary medication. School staff are happy to administer medicines during school time but cannot do so with a completed form.

Collection Arrangements / Permission to Walk Home

A quick reminder to parents that if collection arrangements need to change during the school day, please telephone the office so that we are able to update class staff. If you wish your Year 5 or Year 6 child to walk home from school unaccompanied or to be released from their class to walk to meet you at another classroom on a regular basis, please provide written permission (an email to the office is fine) and this permission will run until you inform us of other arrangements (if any).

Food and Drink in school

A reminder that we operate a "no nuts" policy due to concerns over undiagnosed nut allergies. We encourage healthy balanced meals with both our hot and packed lunches. In packed lunches we do ask that there are no glass bottles, cans of fizzy drinks, or chocolate bars/sweets/chewing gum. It is important to keep hydrated, i.e. not being thirsty, throughout the day as this is good for health and concentration levels. For this reason, children are encouraged to bring reusable "sports type" bottles of water with them into the classroom. All bottles should be clearly named. Your child can bring a fruit or vegetable snack for playtime, this should be brought into the classroom with them (please pack and label it separately from their lunch). Crisps should only be part of a packed lunch, not for snack time.

Ad Hoc MDSA vacancy

We are looking to recruit an ad hoc Lunchtime Supervisory Assistant to ensure we can cover when other supervisors aren't available. Experience of working with children in a voluntary or paid capacity is preferred. We have a really friendly and dedicated lunchtime team and full training will be given. The hours are from 11.45am until 1.15pm school term time only, with a commitment of around two to three days a week. This post requires a criminal background check via the disclosure procedure. Please contact the school office if you are interested.

2025 Admissions Process

School Admissions have asked us to publicise the admissions process for school place applications for September 2025. The online portal will be live for secondary applications from Monday 16 September and for primary applications from Monday 30 September. For children due to transfer to a secondary or upper school the closing date for applications is 31 October 2024 and the national offer day is 3 March 2025. For children due to start school for the first time or transfer to a junior or middle school the closing date for applications is 15th January 2025 and the national offer day is 16 April 2025.

The web pages and primary and secondary admission guides for the 2025 admissions process will be updated from early September and can be found on their website under "Applying for school" (somerset.gov.uk). Parent/carers are advised to read the information thoroughly before making an online application. It is a parent's responsibility to make an application by the closing date.



Bag2School


We have booked our Bag2School collection dates for this academic year and the first one is on **Thursday 26**th **September**. Please bring donations to the lower playground gate by 9am that day.
