Learning App – free trial

It is always important to keep our brains active, just like any of our muscles. So over the summer if you wish to keep your child's brain engaged or want to improve their Maths and Spelling skills, we have a fantastic online recommendation. Sumdog is an online learning tool which provides personalised math and spelling practice for children. It adapts questions to each child, using engaging games to build their confidence, and it has been shown to accelerate progress. Sumdog can be accessed on a computer, mobile or tablet. Go to www.sumdog.com or download the free Sumdog app which is available on Apple or Android. Payment details are required to access the trial (free until August 29th 2022) but you can cancel anytime and you will be sent a reminder email before the trial ends. If you do not wish to cancel your account, the fee is £5.99 a month.
